### **UPDATE: Verizon Cell Tower on Robertson**

On June 29, 2018 Zoning Administrator David Weintraub of the Department of City Planning issued a letter to Verizon and Amy Liu, owner of 2512 Robertson APPROVING the Conditional Use Permit authorizing the installation of an unmanned Wireless Communication facility (WTF) with a 52-feet high monoeucalyptus. #### What you can do:

If you would like to file an appeal for the installation of the Verizon Cell tower then please direct it to Alam Choudhury, City Planning Division Staff for the West/South/Coastal Project Planning at 213-978-1467 by July 16, 2018. It is strongly advised that appeals be filed early during the appeal period and in person. Any appeal must be:

- 1. filed with eight (8) copies of the <u>prescribed forms</u> (1 original and 7 duplicates), a copy can also be found on our website
- 2. include eight (8) copies of the letter of determination from the AZA
- 3. accompanied by the required fee (\$89 + extra charges),
- 4. and received and receipted at one of the public offices listed below.
