We're working through the plan, the original drawings showed us losing an insane number of parking spots, so we pushed back and we're now looking to get to maybe an overall loss of 6-8 spaces, which is a fraction of what showed before. But this means that we fell back in the work schedule a bit. A trade off I think is worth it. So, they are still working through our requested changes. We are also seeing if we can negotiate to pour concrete at all 4 corners of Gibson, which is something else they are trying to make happen.

Long and short is that some work will start by end of year with the concrete stuff happening by mid-year 2019. Definitely a delay, but better to get it right than to deal with the fallout from rushing it through and losing 20+ parking spaces for our businesses.
